Post 27 Farmington, UT Memorial Day program May 31st 2010

On the Friday before Memorial day 2009 Post 27, assisted by city personnel, placed flags on the graves of 350 of our fallen comrades at the Farmington City cemetery. Also on that same day, assisted by the Boy Scouts, the Post placed over 700 flags on the graves of Veterans in the Kaysville City cemetery. A flag ceremony was conducted at each city cemetery on the morning of May 25th.

The proposed program for 2010 will be as follows: On Friday morning May 28th the Post will assist Farmington City personnel place flags on the graves of Veterans in the Farmington City Cemetery. Later in the afternoon, at a time to be determined, we will supervise the placement of flags on the Veterans graves in Kaysville.

The City of Kaysville has asked us to participate in a Memorial Day program May 31st at 10:00 am at the Kaysville cemetery. The program will open with Post 27's Color Guard marching in behind the Davis High Drum line and post the Colors. Commander Hefner will lead in the Pledge of Allegiance.



Kaysville Mayor Hiatt will open with a welcome, and ask for a opening prayer by local clergy. At this point the Mayor will introduce Congressman Rob Bishop for remarks after which the Honor Guard will fire a 3 round volley, Taps will be played by Davis High Student. The Honor guard will retrieve the Colors and follow the Drum line off the field.
